Grade 5: Your child will be utilizing a binder system to help with organizational skills. You will need to purchase a binder with the following specifications:

3 ring, $1 \frac{1}{2}$ inch binder with internal pocket(s). No trapper style binders. Dividers are provided for the children.

School supplies that you will need to provide & have labeled with your child's first and last name:

- 10 #2 pencils (no mechanical please)
- 10 dark blue or black pens
- 2 glue sticks
- crayons or colored pencils

- 1 highlighter
- 4 dry erase markers dark colors
- 2 packages of reinforced margin, wide ruled, loose leaf paper (not college ruled)
- 2 red pens
- 1 ruler (with standard and metric measurements)
- 1 two pocket folder for Music
- 1 Composition book for Spanish, 1 English/Spanish dictionary,
- 1 two pocket folder for Art, an art smock or old shirt for messier Art days
- 1 two pocket paper folder, 1 hand sanitizer, 1 box of tissues for Music
- 2 composition books (non-spiral)

- 1 black fine point Sharpie and 1 black ultra-fine point Sharpie
- 1 package of water-based markers (like Crayola)
- 1 plastic pencil box to hold individual supplies
- 3 rolls of paper towels, 3 boxes of tissues, 3 containers of disinfectant wipes
- 1 computer mouse (wireless is easier for students to manage)
- 1 spiral notebook for Library

- 1 set of headphones or earbuds to keep at school. Must be small enough to fit in the flat front pocket of the student Chromebook carrying case. No Air Pods or other Bluetooth devices.

Two paperback novels are required (this can be purchased or borrowed from the Library. Purchasing the books is recommended as it is read over the course of a few months and students often take notes on the pages.)
